# Review of: "Multifaceted Management of Severe Pancytopenia in a Diabetic Patient: A Case of MRSE-Induced Bone Marrow Suppression"

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Overall, the case was well managed.

Sepsis-related myelosuppression is well known in clinical practice and responds well to adequate antimicrobials.

Whether hematological recovery is due to the addition of antibiotics as per the culture report or to eltrombopag is unclear, and the onset of action of EPAG is not that fast in clinical practice.

The possibility of a hematolymphoid neoplasm, especially myelofibrosis, by NGS should be done.

A repeat bone marrow aspirate and biopsy with microbiological investigation from the marrow would be helpful.
