This study addresses a contemporary and relevant topic, which is in line with the current global situation.

However, the coherence between the introductory section and the subsequent method and results sections appears somewhat perplexing. In the introduction, the research objectives are stated as follows: (1) the development of a digital framework for enhancing resilience and academic skills among tertiary-level students from the perspective of Society 5.0, (2) the assessment of the digital conditions of resilience and academic skills among students in Indonesia, adopting the Society 5.0 viewpoint, and (3) the identification and description of the factors influencing digital resilience and academic skills among students from the Society 5.0 perspective. Nevertheless, the method employed seems to align more with instrument development, raising concerns about its ability to effectively address the research questions. Additional elaboration on the relationship between the chosen method and its potential to address the research questions would be beneficial. Further clarity in the method section will strengthen the overall cohesiveness of the study.
