

Review of: "Developing and Evaluating the Marriage Education Program: The Example of the Turkish Cypriot Community"

- 1. The Abstract and Results state that an independent samples t-test was used, while the Method section states that a paired t-test was used. Paired t-test is the appropriate analysis for pre-post data. Which analysis was used?
- 2. The first sentence of the Introduction needs a citation.
- 3. The second paragraph of the Introduction discusses a philosophy that is later defined as constructivism. This should be explained here.
- 4. The authors mention divorce rates increasing, yet the United States divorce rate has decreased since 1980.
- 5. The authors state that marriage education programs increase "marriage-related behaviors." What are these behaviors?
- 6. The study about self-healing training does not seem to relate to marriage education.
- 7. For the studies given prior to the mention of US marriage education, what countries were they conducted in?
- 8. The study by Alipour (2020) showed no difference between the experimental and control groups so it should not be cited as an example of effective marriage education.
- After the mention of US marriage education, there should be at least one study that presents an evaluation of a US program.
- 10. In Section 2.1, the marriage education program's content and structure should be described in detail.
- 11. What is a "semi-experimental" design? Is this a quasi-experimental design?
- 12. The sampling strategy of "easily accessible sampling variety" needs to be explained.
- 13. For the professionals who reviewed the interview questions, how was their feedback incorporated?
- 14. The two measures used in the study need to be described with what scale they are on, example items, and coefficient alphas.
- 15. How were the interviews taped?
- 16. What are "NVivo coding strategies"?
- 17. The authors state that content analysis was used yet they do not put their results in specific categories then label examples. Was this the correct analysis?
- 18. How does the Coding Comparison Query work and relate to the other coding that was done?
- 19. It states that participants were interviewed before the start of the study. Was this data part of the analysis?
- 20. Where were interviews conducted?



- 21. Sample questions from the interview need to be given.
- 22. The paragraph above #3 is repetitive with other information and needs to be integrated with where the information was previously mentioned.
- 23. What does "dependency on the root family" mean?
- 24. Only two of the four themes have figures with quotes attached to them with arrows. There should be a figure for each theme.
- 25. There should be longer quotes given to support each theme in text.
- 26. The study in the Discussion that states that marriage and relationship education reduced work stress does not fit in the paper, as this paper is not related to work stress.
- 27. When the qualitative findings are introduced in the Discussion, the four themes should be discussed with literature to support them.
- 28. Where it says, "increasing the number of samples," it should say, "number of subjects."
- 29. After this quote, the results of the qualitative analysis are summarized a second time but this text can be eliminated as this information has already been covered.
- 30. There needs to be a Limitations section that discusses limited generalizability due to using a non-probability sampling method and only conducting the study in Cyprus. The small sample size should also be mentioned.
- 31. The paper would benefit from a thorough English edit by a native English speaker, as there are grammar errors throughout the paper.
