

Review of: "Statistical Overview of Prevalence of Anaemia with Associated Socioeconomic and Demographic Factors in Nigeria"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

Comments:

- It is not mentioned in the title or in the objective that the study is based on a survey on malaria, which is important to specify.
- Likewise, in the title and objective, it is necessary to mention the age group of the study population.
- In the Introduction, it is necessary to reference the assertions.
- In the Introduction, the importance or association of malaria with the topic of study is not mentioned. Malaria is only included as one of the infections associated with anemia.
- Reference to Research and Methods is required.
- In Results, Table 3.3, it is required to include the raw ORs, since only the adjusted ones are shown. These cannot be compared with the bivariate analysis in the previous table.
- Neither the Discussion nor the Conclusions explain the association between the associated variables (statistically significant) in the multivariate analysis and malnutrition in children under 5 years of age, neither with the context in Nigeria, in general, nor in 2021.
