I find that Blanco does a great job of synthesising, in a clear and yet profound way, Catholicism in just 13 words. However, I think that sometimes the use of metaphorical - and even poetic - language can leave several ambiguities about the concrete meaning of the sentences.

In addition, the section on the covenant could be revised. From the wording, it seems as if it only links Christianity with the history of the prophets and the patriarchs, leaving the history of the infidelities of the Old Testament completely aside. Perhaps emphasising, as Nostra Aetate does, that the pillars of Christianity are born in the Jewish people would help to give a more interwoven history.
