Type 1 oculocutaneous albinism (OCA1) describes a group of tyrosine related OCAs (see this term) that includes OCA1A, OCA1B, type 1 minimal pigment oculocutaneous albinism (OCA1-MP) and type 1 temperature sensitive oculocutaneous albinism (OCA1-TS) (see these terms).
