

## Review of: "Larache's Coastal in Morocco: Evaluating Dredging's Impact on Fisheries and Shorelineevolution"

The article describes the changes in the coastline of the Larache coastal area in Morocco and attempts to find a correlation between dredging activities, the physical evolution of the coastline, and variation in the quantity of fish landed in the Larache region. Based on the attempt to find a correlation between these factors, the authors have succeeded to a certain degree. However, this is surely not the first article to attempt to find a correlation between dredging, the physical evolution of coastlines, and the associated impacts on marine life. Therefore, for the article to have more academic value, the "6. Discussion of the Results" section should, as its title suggests, have more discussion of the factors and their relation to each other, and should also be supplemented with comparisons of results from previous similar studies. Adding more discussion to the "6. Discussion of the Results" section would improve the article immeasurably and elevate it from its current status, whereby it reads more like a technical report than an academic article. But the article, subject, and title definitely have academic value.
