1. The article should be written in appropriate for scientific papers style in English, as well as grammatically.
2. There is no description of cancer situation in Brunei.
3. Malignant pleural effusion is not an extremely rare pathology - 18 cases are not sufficient for a correct statistic analysis. The study cohort must be completed or the author must provide the reason why the cohort is so small.
4. There are some incorrectly used terms, it's not clear, what means complete response or partial response - which criteria are used for evaluation.
5. The article cannot be accepted as it is and requires major correction with re-review
