

Review of: "A trabecular micro-bypass stent combined with phacoemulsification efficiently reduces intraocular pressure in open angle glaucoma in Mexican population"

This is a case series involving 26 glaucoma patients who underwent combined cataract and glaucoma surgery with iStent implantation.

There are several areas in this paper that require improvement. Firstly, the methodology lacks clarity. It does not specify the nature of the trial; for instance, whether it is retrospective or prospective. Additionally, there is no control group included. To better understand the efficacy in terms of lowering intraocular pressure, a comparison between iStent alone, phaco alone, and combined surgery is necessary. Furthermore, baseline characteristics are missing. We do not have information on preoperative IOP, best-corrected visual acuity, or the number of medications used.

All of these limitations should be addressed in the Discussion section.

Lastly, the paper should be written in better English.
