The authors describe their experience of epilepsy surgery in patients with tuberous sclerosis complex. In my opinion, it is an interesting article, but there are some questions to be addressed:

In the abstract, there are abbreviations that do not have its meaning next to it ("TSC" and "DRE").

The introduction is too long and it contains irrelevant information. It loses its main objective.

The authors should provide more information about ictal onset, inter-ictal findings, MRI and neurophysiological data when describing the results.

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
