Comments

- 1. Objectives were not mentioned clearly.
- 2. Methodology Paragraph 1, last line. 2 to me written in word, two
- 3. One of the objectives is blood pressure control among patients attending a tertiary health centre, but in the results section, there is no table/figure about the blood pressure control.
- 4. Results mention blood pressure control.

Results show that 1% of the participants were not taking any drugs. In that case, the reason for the doctors' consultation, if blood pressure is at a higher level, whether due to the financial burden they are not taking the medicine, or if they are following any other method to control blood pressure, needs to be justified.

5. Conclusion with a sub-optimal level of blood pressure control - No supporting data.

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
