- 1. Research question 2 Students' attitude towards waste classification and the following design, the author designed several questions, but they are slightly repetitive (for example, source classification of solid waste is a necessary condition for solid waste management inside and outside the school, which is similar to the possible measurement content of the following question).
- 2. There is no good explanation for why human dynamics is chosen as a non-environmental education control group
- 3. How to control the two groups from being interfered by non-classroom educational activities, which is an important prerequisite to ensure the accuracy of the conclusion
