

Review of: "Fluids, Vasopressors and Inotropes to Restore Heart-Vessels Coupling in Sepsis: Treatment Options and Perspectives"

The article is very interesting and well written with correct citation of sources. The description of the two clinical cases is interesting and educational. However, in the tables, the normal range of creatinine (0.16-0.39 mg/dL) is not clear to me.

The article refers to the usefulness of fluid boluses in intensive care; however, no attention is paid to the type of solutions used. It would be useful to delve deeper into the use of balanced, saline, and albumin solutions.

Furthermore, the usefulness of fluid balance or the use of diuretics to maintain it is not mentioned.

I think the article is suitable for the journal and publication after minor revisions.

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
