Overall, the idea presented in the article is good, but there have been a lot of studies in the literature addressing this issue. If there are only two groups which are going to be compared, then why has the F-statistic been used here?

Secondly, the introductory section of the article is remarkably concise and falls short of providing a thorough overview of the current state of the field. Additionally, the arrangement of tests and their respective options interrupts the reading flow and might be more appropriately placed in an appendix. The presentation of results is structured as a numbered list, mirroring the brevity observed in both the introduction and the conclusions. The latter, too, is notably succinct.

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
