- 3. The authors have not followed the appropriate manuscript format. The objectives of the study are included only after studying literature and identifying the possible research gaps to be addressed. This principle is not followed in the structure of the manuscript and author may please re-look on this point.
- 4. Author have also mentioned about NEP 2020 and it would be prudent to include a little detailed explanation of what NEP is for the international audience.
- 5. Did authors receive Ethical Approval to carry out the study using structured questionnaire? What was the mode of sending the guestionnaire? What sampling method was used? Whether guestionnaire was validated?

Addressing above may help improve the overall structure.
