The article is well-written with significant objectives. I have a few comments as below:

- 1. I suggest finding more recent references regarding the total population number for the West Shewa Zone (page 4).
- 2. To include the SPSS version that was used. Section: data entry, processing, and statistical analysis (Page 5).
- 3. I suggest checking the statistical analysis methods that have been used.
- 4. Result data for Table 1, please present as mean +- SD or as mean (pages 6-7).
- 5. Please standardize the writing format. For example, diabetic nephropathy has been addressed as DN and sometimes as diabetic nephropathy.
- 6. On page 9, under Independent Predictors of DN, please list down the factors that have been adjusted. Paragraph 2, "after adjusting for other factors....."
- 7. In the discussion, not so much the burden of DN among adults with diabetes was discussed. Since the burden of DN is one of the objectives of this study, I suggest adding more information on the burden in the results and discussion.
