The review manuscript is interesting, but I have some suggestions for the author to consider, which are as follows:

The author did a good job of conveying all relevant information about the manuscript topic, but he did so in a manner that is brief.

The importance of biofilm in sinus bacterial infections is not sufficiently highlighted in this manuscript, nor are the non-antibiotic alternatives to therapy discussed, that are frequently the most crucial because antibiotics are not probable to be able to completely eradicate the formation of biofilm bacteria.

A more comprehensive and insightful discussions about "sinusitis" need to address the function of the biofilm phenotype, the difference between chronic and acute sinus infections, as well as when prescription drugs need to be used instead of antimicrobial agents.

The author should double-check the references list to ensure that it follows journal style.
