I think it is a relevant topic and points out to an interactive way of teaching, aligned with the most updated pedagogical theories (active learning, student-centered approaches, etc).

I agree with other comments that your work can be improved by adding theoretical foundations that highlight this important direction you are already pointing out. It will strength your background section. I also agree you should provide more details in your stats results. Currently they seem to have undertaken a bit superficial analysis.

I think you can also refine your manuscript by correcting some typo issues, such as lack of space between word ('atleast', 'aforum'). It worth making a detailed reading to verify these mistakes. Also, avoid using informal language (e.g., "'engineering thing").

I hope my comments help you to improve the overall quality of work.
