Dear authors, the review is well written and analyses in details different aspects of the antibacterial effect of several plants against some antiobiotic-resistance strains of bacterial pathogens. I suggest you to revise the Table 1, adding a final columns with the references, and to revise the names of the genera (for both plants and bacteria). In particular, you should revise the abbreviation of the genera, adding a dot after the first letter (i.e., *S. aureus* or *T. vulgaris*). Moreover, I suggest to introduce the full name of the bacterial genera in the title of the paragraph, such as "Staphylococcus aureus".

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
