Review of: "Picture Fuzzy, Hesitant Fuzzy, and Spherical Fuzzy SuperHyperGraph"

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It is unclear why the author mentions "independent researcher" under their name in the article. This designation seems unnecessary unless it serves a specific purpose.

References are generally not included in the abstract, but the author has added too many, which is not in line with standard academic practice.

In the introduction, multiple references are cited at the same place without proper explanation or context, which affects clarity and coherence.

The article does not clearly establish a solid research gap. A more focused identification and justification of the gap are needed.

The limitations of existing structures should be discussed more thoroughly, particularly from a mathematical point of view.

There appears to be no clear application of the structured theory presented in the article.

Overall, the presentation of the article is weak and requires significant improvement in structure, clarity, and academic rigor.
