General

In general I think we need a clear research question/aims and objectives and a more detailed explanation of the methods. What methods were doing in the research? We don't need to list them necessarily, but the goal of the research needs to be stated I think. Were they exploring the problem or thinking about the solution? So I think the results/discussion section needs to directly link the data collected to the problems identified earlier in the paper - and how the different data collection methods contributed differently. Some rationale (citations) for the research design would also strengthen the paper I think.

Comment in results and discussion

I think this section needs reorganisation. As it is, it is descriptive and doesn't directly respond to the issues raised in the introduction - there needs to be a link between the problems experienced in Indonesia and how the data collected points to a solution to that problem - so the introduction/lit review might give evidence of the problem and how parking systems work elsewhere - then the discussion would be about how these solutions can address the problems in Indonesia. This section also needs to explain what data was collected and how - for example, what are the results of the data? Is it more evidence of the problem or is it to do with perceptions of the solution? What questions were asked?

Comment in conclusion

So I think we need a better understanding of what the research did - did the data expose the problem that SewaDia rent can solve, or did the data provide insight into how SewaDeia can work etc etc - I think having a clear research question and aims/objectives stated at the end of the literature review would help making everything make sense

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
