The paper is a good attempt with relevant econometric approaches. Still, i have some comments.

- 1- The author have to clearly report the contribution of the manuscript, in the introduction section.
- 2- Summary of the literature is missing, which should be at the end of the literature section.
- 3- Some of therelevant studies are missing from the literature, which need to be included, such as:

- 4- The author mentiond in the title "Russia-Ukrain" war, but the data is till April 2022. It means the post war data is not enough to incorporate the exact findings of post war era.
- 5- The author used the simple GARCH approach (DCC), i recommend to adopt the asymmetric GARCH approaches, such as cDCC, GO-GARCH for negative and positive shocks. Follow the mentioned papers:
