The article also needs to be edited for instance there is a persistent switching between "I" and "we" when referring to the researchers

The methodology and approach section seems to be missing, or not clearly outlined. This is a very crucial section to build credibility of the paper

I also suggest that the findings be enhanced with statistics to support the various claims made. also more linkage to the elaborated theories would create a better synthesis.
