- **For Q.3** the answer could be elaborated more as it stands for the significance of the research.
- **For Q.7** Likewise it was mentioned in c and d options for the first two a and b it would be more effective to also state how your work differs.
- **Q.8** I believe it needs a lit bit more explanation of the most recent major developments in your area.
- **In Q.9** why did you use this research methodology? as a reflective practitioner/researcher you need to ground your discussion on more scientifically proven facts or explanations regarding the research methodology you had chosen
- **For Q.10** evaluation of your work, it is stated that quantitative and qualitative methods were used. Support your answers by using a reference for instance Silverman (2011) in qualitative research and support your explanations rather than generalising your ideas all the time. This is valid for Q.9 (as emphasized above) and 11.
- Overall, I found the questions and answers effective but the only concern I felt is while answering the questions, there is a tendency to generalise most of the answers and that might cause to lose the focus of presenting a scientific research paper.
