This work falls short of the expected standards for scientific innovation and contribution to the field. It appears more suited for a graduate-level mini-project than for publication in its current state. The paper lacks clarity in organization and suffers from numerous grammatical errors throughout.

One of the major drawbacks is the lack of clearly defined objectives, which makes it challenging for readers to grasp the significance and direction of the research. Moreover, the paper fails to distinguish itself in a field where several superior articles exist. Mere hybridization of natural fibers without a specific end-use focus, coupled with poor laminate fabrication techniques and inadequate property analysis, does not meet the threshold for publication.

Overall, this work needs substantial refinement and a clearer delineation of its goals and contributions to advance scientific understanding in the domain of natural fiber reinforced composites.
