The content of the article is both relevant, needed, and timely. And its relevance is clearly confirmed in the introduction. There are all the main elements of research presented in the article, which enable others - the readers or other researchers - to execute or repeat the research in any other context. All this allows the author to draw evidence-based conclusions, but on the other hand - because of the objective limits of the research - only descriptive analysis is presented in the article, as well as the comparative analysis with the other university, which is only mentioned without deeper analysis.

Generally, the article is quite good, and improvements according to the comments (also from the other reviewers) would give higher quality to it.
