The manuscript was well articulated and written. However, I have these few concerns to point out:

- 1."Ganoderma extracts have demonstrated the ability to disrupt biofilms formed by pathogenic bacteria, making it easier for the immune system and antimicrobial agents to target and eliminate the bacteria." An emphatic statement like this can't go uncited.
- 2. "AgNO3 was reduced to produce silver nanoparticles via a green process mediated by mycelial extracts of G. lucidum that have improved stability and excellent dispersion..." This statement, apart from disjoining the preceding paragraph, couldn't convey its meaning clearly.
- 3. The article laid less emphasis on the microbial enzymes' role in MDR and the potential of the plant in their inhibition.

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
