This is a very interesting article, focusing on a still under-researched area, which makes it valuable. The topic has lots of potential for study. However, the article may require some revisions and additional information.

First, in the Introduction, the statistics related to TikTok could be updated, as some of the data is from 2020. For such a dynamic platform as TikTok, three years should make a considerable difference. The presentation of the platform could also mention more controversial aspects, leading to bans of TikTok in some locations. A more detailed profile of TikTok users would be beneficial, too. Does TikTok users' base include university all university students?

It would be beneficial to place the current discussion of TikTok in the broader context of social media in the academic environment, which is relatively well researched.

The biggest problem, in my opinion, is a missing explicit methodological part. What method of literature analysis was applied? Was it Systematic Literature Review? How were the publications sampled? What were the inclusion criteria? How was the material gathered analysed? This is missing and it is the most important weakness. This should be presented immediately after the Introduction. Why was the analysis divided into the presented research streams? Finally, the authors could suggest areas of further research.
