In this study, the authors conducted a systematic review of literature to identify cases of retinal vasculitis following COVID-19 infection. Though a very interesting topic, I have some comments on the manuscript.

- 1. IN THE ABSTRACT: In the purpose, please specify that you identified cases of RETINAL vasculitis following COVID-
- 2. IN THE ABSTRACT: Please rewrite the conclusion to match the found results and the purpose of the study!
- 3. IN THE ABSTRACT and in the first line of the results: Change the word describing in the results to describe.
- 4. In the introduction: No references whatsoever were mentioned. Please add references for the introduction.
- 5. In case of many consecutive references, please mention, for example, 1-10 instead of writing all the numbers.
- 6. In the results section: Please mention the period of follow-up of the patients till full recovery and the detailed modality of treatment.
- 7. In the discussion section: In the last paragraph, you mentioned, "Potential causative mechanisms include the presence of a prothrombotic state due to endothelial injury or inflammation. "Please explain this sentence. Was the prothrombotic state a cause of the retinal vasculitis? Did any of the included papers study blood tests for hypercoagulability?

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
