I read your article with a great interest. Introduction part is too long and give unnecessary details (such as pandemic declaration, first case at Wuhan etc) that readers already know. At methodology you mentioned reason of deaths will be given at the next version of the study. But it is an important limitation and all the related data should be given in a single study. Results section repeats the data at the tables and it is too long. Also it should be better if you give a bit detail about lockdown strategy than giving the dates with much details. Discussion part is too short. You didn't give data about variant but at discussion you directly talked about omicron. Please give data about the reason of deaths? All they are because of covid? Why is there a sharp increase at may 2021? Conclusion is too long.
