Proof reading is needed to correct citation errors for example line 2 in the introduction; line 2 in the literature review section.

Provide a brief discussion of agritourism in Zimbabwe in the introduction section the same way you did for SA, Tanzania, Morocco etc. End the section by highlighting the research gap informed by the discussion you have done.

Since the conceptual framework is based on a review of literature, the authors need to ensure that there is a critical integration of various literature sources. In certain instances the authors minimally cited previous research.

In the Zimbabwean context it would be interesting to show the prospects and challenges posed by the land reform to agritourism.

A strong discussion on the SDGs supported by literature is needed. The authors can also explore the contribution of agritourism to SDG 3, 10 & 11.

Authors should provide a conclusion. Alternatively the last section titled Implications to practice and policy can be changed to Conclusion where the theoretical and practical implications are discussed. The section should end with limitations and recommendations for further studies.
