

Review of: "[Review Article] Cytomegalovirus Infection"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

Review Abdullah D. describes the well-known, basic information about cytomegalovirus infection. The topic is important; however, the manuscript is poorly written, refers to old and inadequate data and should be modified.

The phrase "CMV" or "HCMV" should be used in the whole manuscript.

The sentence "CMV (...) is rather common in adulthood" should refer to the frequency presented as percentages.

There is no information about the glycoprotein complex II, neither on Figure 1 nor in the text.

Abbreviations "hematopoietic stem cell transplantation (SCT)" and "solid organ transplantation (SOT)" have been provided twice to the manuscript, it should be corrected.

The manuscript in a few parts describes the clinical manifestations of CMV infection but without the clear division for congenital and postnatal CMV infection.

Information about the potential vaccine should be included at the end of the Treatment and Prevention section.
