The author introduces many new terms, arguments, and mathematical derivations making this paper difficult to understand. The references which usually serve as a starting point in discussing a new theory are almost entirely unfamiliar to me. As his theory is currently presented it would require too large an investment in time for me to make a meaningful and thus helpful suggestions for improvement. I would suggest making less reference to his own previous supporting work and trying to connect his ideas to those of well known authors on the foundations such as Feynman, Dirac, and Einstein. This would allow me, and other readers in general, to have some basis for beginning to understand how his ideas give a better interpretation of the foundations than previous interpretations.
