- 1 This study uses a rigorous attitude to analyze three urban cases, and defines social activities and space syntax as highly related. It has made a contribution to the field of spatial behavior research. This study is worthy of praise.
- 2.It is recommended to add a research flow chart to Chapter-Research Method and explain the 3 city cases and key points of field surveys, which can increase the understanding of statistical data.
- 3.It is recommended to add reasons and reasons for selecting these three cities, and how completing this research will help the urban management or safety and security of these three cities.

4.In the fourth paragraph of the discussion chapter, it is mentioned that the local integration has stronger correlations than the global type. According to the results of the same study, historical contexts have more social interactions than modern cases. It is recommended that these 3 research city cases have the some obviously characteristics and are the statistical results of the research before such a definition can be made. After all, this is a critical research conclusion that is different from the behavioral characteristics of most modern cities, especially modern cities with parks, squares, community centers, shopping malls, city hall centers, etc. Therefore, it is recommended that the discussion chapter should return to the literature review and to feedback reviews of the previously studies in Space Syntax Theory. it is better enable readers to understand the value of this study, and respond the research results of previous scholars.
