The article is quite fascinating and showcases a high level of innovation. However, I have a few comments to share:

To enhance reader readability, it would be beneficial to divide the Abstract into smaller subsections.

The aim of the study and the methods employed to justify the concepts of ancient Indian medical sciences need further clarification in terms of exposition.

It would be helpful to provide a clearer explanation of the concepts of nadi pariksha and E-HEALTH ANALYSIS in the Introduction paragraph, possibly by including a definition.

To bolster the scholarly credibility, it is advisable to augment the number of bibliographic references as the study currently lacks sufficient citations.
