### **General comment**

The authors raised a very significant public health concern as the recurrence of pulmonary tuberculosis is a much convenient way to measure the effectiveness of TB control programs and identify the target population groups. The manuscript is well written, incorporating basic research paper sections and sub-sections. The findings are well organized and discussed with sufficient citations to previous similar works. Hence, the manuscript has scientific merit. However, before considering it for publication, I suggest the following specific comments to be addressed.

- Please avoid abbreviations/acronyms in this section or define them on their first appearance.
- The conclusion in this section was not drawn based on your findings. Please consider this and contextualize it to your specific study.

· Your study population is 'all forms TB' patients, including extrapulmonary TB cases. Why was your data limited to



pulmonary cases only?

- What were your 'inclusion and exclusion criteria' in selecting the study participants?
- For example, your study subjects were adults. Why did you exclude children?

· How did you address ethical concerns?

  this important variable.
