

Review of: "Nutritional Status and Dietary Patterns of Children Aged Ten Years and Below In the Buea Municipality, South West Region Cameroon"

The authors have conducted a study on 354 participants to assess the relationship between dietary patterns and nutritional status of children up to the age of 10 years in the district of Buea. They can substantiate their methodology by adding the total population of the district in either introduction or study population. The pretested questionnaire to collect health related factors and household characteristics data needs more elaboration in terms of statistical results (validity scores). The food frequency questionnaire needs to be described in details especially the parameters it measures. How the food frequency questionnaire was related to the nutritional status (wasting, stunting and BMI) should be included. Other findings are appropriate. Discussion can be improved by comparing few more studies under each headings. All other aspects of the article are well compiled and well presented.

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
