A version of a research article that has been (or is going to be) submitted to a peer-reviewed journal before amendment resulting from the peer review process for that journal. Given that such articles have not yet undergone peer review, a preprint should not be considered the final version of the article, but as a draft for comment and discussion. The final accepted version of an article should include a link to the preprint through its DOI and the preprint should be updated with a link to the final accepted version through its DOI.
