The idea behind the presented work is interesting. However, the research has several flaws that must be addressed so it can be accepted:

- 1. References are mostly old, and new references exist that must be included here. We suggest that the authors could execute a systematic literature review, instead of what it suggests to be just a preliminary review.
- 2. There's the need to consult important and strategic documents produced by very important bodies like OECD. None of those documents is referenced here.
- 3. Even the tables with data stop at 2020. It is now 4 years ago.
- 4. For this research, there is no support from a scientific methodology. Since, how can it be considered as a scientific production?
- 5. In the end, the contribution of the work, besides being outdated, is not clear.

We recommend a deep revision of the paper before it can be resubmitted for new evaluation.

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
