Although the conclusions of this study are interesting and may lead to the improvement of management practices in the field of road construction, I believe that the literature consulted to theoretically substantiate this study is old or very old.

For example, considering that we are in the year 2024, the phrase, "It is estimated that globally, road construction work has one of the highest accident rates compared to other industries (Abe and Tamura, 2011)," seems irrelevant and without support due to the very old bibliographic source.
