

Review of: "Misdiagnosis of Dengue Fever as Malaria and Typhoid Fever and Their Co-infection in Rural Areas of Southwest Nigeria"

The manuscript addresses some of the challenges in the misdiagnosis of infections in Nigeria; however, I have a few comments. Firstly, I would recommend a thorough revision of the grammar throughout the manuscript to enhance clarity and readability. Furthermore, I noticed a discrepancy in the presentation of data in Tables [Fig. III, Fig. IV, and Fig. V]. The overlapping ranges on the x-axis, such as [1.76, 5.76] and [5.76, 9.76], could potentially compromise the visual interpretation of the data. I would suggest exploring alternative tools to reproduce these tables to rectify this issue and ensure the accuracy and coherence of the visual representations. Additionally, in the discussion section, there appears to be a discrepancy concerning the reporting of confidence intervals. While confidence intervals are mentioned, they seem to contain only a single value.
