

# Review of: "Influence of Motivation on Pre-service Primary Teachers' Performance in Mathematics"

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This is an interesting work that measures the incidence of intrinsic and extrinsic motivation variables of teachers in the teaching of mathematics. In general terms, it seems to me to be a good work, with a very interesting subject matter and an adequate study methodology. I propose some improvements in this respect:

- Enrichment of the theoretical framework with some of the studies that have been concerned with analyzing these same issues in other areas of knowledge, such as the social sciences.
- Greater precision in the description of the questionnaire, explaining whether it is elaborated on a Likert scale, and what this scale is.
- Description of the statistical tests applied.
- Enrichment of the discussion phase with similar studies.
