I was disappointed that they did not go into a more detailed review of the issue of bone turnover as demonstrated by bone markers Although its not clear cut there is some merit in using CTX at least for research if not clinical guidance I would also draw the authors attention to out large prospective clinical study on extractions for osteoporotic patients on denosumab Collela *et al.* JOMS 2023 From that we agree that extractions best left to 6 months after the last injection of denosumab We would certainly avoid extractions after only 3 wees after the last injection At that stage the bone turnover is still very low.

Apart from these minor comments its an excellent contribution to the world literature.
