- The conclusions from the analysis are not clearly listed. It is important to explain these in a way that helps public health policymakers understand how they can use these results to make actionable decisions.
- The connection between the pneumonia vulnerabilities and Covid is not clear. A small case study or application of this analysis on Covid data data will help the reader understand how conclusions can potentially change with disease.
