

Review of: "The use of tele-education in medicine, during and beyond the COVID-19 pandemic: A commentary"

The article deals with a topic of interest and topicality, since COVID-19 represented an unprecedented change in adapting face-to-face education to the virtual format, also in the field of medical education. The paper describes the impact of COVID on the population and society, but without going into the core of the work, education in the field of medicine. The section explaining the methodology should be more precise and detailed. For example, how were the keywords selected? How was the analysis carried out? Was any kind of contrast performed? If it is a systematic review, it is not explained how it was developed. It would be interesting to refer to relevant databases such as WOS or Scopus. The results present a brief analysis of different aspects (it is not clear how they have been grouped or where these categories come from). The review of previous literature should be expanded, especially since this is the core methodology of the study.

The discussion is coherent and brings relevant works, which allow interesting conclusions to be drawn. The limitations of the study could be expanded, as well as the lines for the future.
