For example, section 5.1 highlights adaptability and flexibility, followed by section 5.2, the role of business model innovation, section 5.3, business models in real terms, 5.4 practical application, and 5.5, the role of business innovation. I can see there are two sections (5.2 and 5.5) with the same title of subsection; this is confusing. Further, the relationship and flow of each section is not explained, so the reader must easily get lost with the findings. Also, section 6 is not clear as a section. Is it a part of the findings?

When it comes to the conclusion, I saw a lack of future recommendations as a result of the systematic literature reviews. Please elaborate deeper.

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
