Dear authors,

The paper must be revised due to the following issues:

- It is not clear what the subjects, objects, theses, hypotheses, research tasks, limitations, etc., are as stated by the
 authors. These must be clearly stated in the introduction section.
- The paper does not include novelty, and it is hard to find the research contributions.
- There is nothing scientific about the publication, which presents well-known facts, and there is no applied instrument for their argumentation.
- The reference list must be extended because only 13 papers are not enough for scientific argumentation, discussion, and results.
- Suggestions for future research on the topic are missing. Although the pandemic situation in the world is basically over, it would be interesting to compare the situation before and after the pandemics.
- The research methodology is missing. Furthermore, the paper does not present any statistical data that is a contribution of the authors, for instance, secondary data analyses, desk research, deductive and/or inductive methods, etc.
- From my point of view, the paper needs basic revision before publication. I suggest deepening the research using
 published papers in other journals, and my recommendation is to include papers published in SCOPUS Q1, Q2/WEB
 of Science.

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
