Abstract needs modification; it is too general, and too many definitions are present. It should address the whole manuscript's theme. In the abstract, citing a researcher is not a good practice.

Introduction: Unusual bold sentences, and the section doesn't discuss the novelty and contribution of the author. It looks like AI tools are used for writing purposes. The novelty and contribution need to be explicitly mentioned in the introduction section.

Sections 2 and 3 can be merged into one subheading of "Background." Authors are more inclined to discussing generative AI, but it seems the whole manuscript is written through AI tools.

There are severe formatting issues across the manuscript.

References are not cited properly across the manuscript.

Related to deep fake, no literature is being discussed by the authors. Since it's a type of review, no comparison of the techniques is provided.

Overall, the manuscript lacks technicality and may not be considered for publication in its current form.

By incorporating experimentation, the work may be impactful as the topic is more attractive in the current era.
