The paper is an important study but it seems more related to fundamental and theoretical sides than to applied examples. The author may analyze some sides by data or statistics or maps to clarify to the learner some important ideas like, for example, the transformation of the small peasantry to workers. Also the impact of the companies, which operate in the space of study in the local economy and ecosystems, will have been well analyzed by concrete data. I think he can write a good paper if he exceeds the descriptive and the impressionist style of writing, mainly in ecological impact of the intervention of the new companies in rural areas. A true serious comparison between the traditional agriculture practiced by small peasantry and specified to self-sufficiency and the modern agriculture oriented to markets. Maps of localization and of some examples of study field are also necessary to a good paper oriented to international scientific community.
