- The concept of sustainable development in relation to MSMEs was not clearly defined. The
 measurement/operationalisation of each of the variables in the study should be clearly established. It is not clear
 whether they were measured as latent variables or directly observable measures.
- 2. The factors such as access to finance, access to information, etc and their effects of MSMEs are widely known in the literature. It'd have been more interesting to have introduced and test the effects of certain moderators in the direct relationships.
- 3. It isn't clear what the knowledge contribution is. Taking point 2 into consideration could resolve this issue. The contribution to theory is not clearly stated.
